

# Helping Texas Counties Become More Energy Efficient



- I. Electric Utility Marketing Managers of Texas (EUMMOT) is a voluntary organization of electric investor-owned utilities formed to address utility industry energy efficiency issues and serve as a forum to facilitate coordination among the energy efficiency program managers.
- II. EUMMOT will work with SECO to help counties understand currently available energy efficiency programs and help counties leverage stimulus funding for maximum effectiveness in energy efficiency programs.
- III. Standard Offer Programs (SOPs) have been implemented by all of the state's larger investor-owned electric utilities to provide incentives to energy service companies and other providers of energy efficiency services for installation of qualifying energy efficiency measures.
- IV. The Commercial Standard Offer Program uses pre-approved savings estimates for lighting, HVAC equipment, and window film, with no additional M&V required.
- V. Energy Efficient Programs targeted to support participating city and county governments through benchmarking, planning, technical assistance, and cash incentives
- VI. The Solar PV Incentive Programs offer a one time incentive towards the price of a solar installation for residential, commercial and government/non-profit entities.
